Dear Mr. Kremer:

On November 13, 2014, the Department of Environmental Protection, Northeast District received a request to extend the expiration date of the above referenced construction permit from January 30, 2015 to July 31, 2015, in order to allow sufficient time to conduct the following: to complete the subject project authorized by Permit No. 0010049-014-AC; to conduct the required performance tests for both this project and another project for the subject facility that is in the draft permitting process (draft file number 0010049-016-AC); and to allow time for submission of the Application for an Air Permit - Non Title V Source within the required time frame. Please be reminded that the aforementioned completed Application for Air Permit - Non Title V Source, which includes DEP Form No. 62-210.900(3), F.A.C., for an operations permit, shall be submitted to the Department at least 90 days prior to this expiration date of July 31, 2015 of the construction permit [per Specific Condition 7 of Section 2 of the subject construction permit, Chapter 62-210, and Rules 62-4.030, 62-4.050, and 62-4.220, F.A.C.].

Determination: Based on the circumstances and information provided, the Department approves this request. The expiration date of the subject permit is hereby extended from **January 30, 2015 to July 31, 2015**. A copy of this letter shall be filed with the referenced permit and shall become part of the permit. This permitting decision, to extend the expiration date of the subject construction permit, is issued pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 62-210.300(1)(a), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

Permitting Authority: Applications for air construction permits (for Non-Title V Sources) are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, F.S., and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

EXTENSION OF AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT EXPIRATION DATE

The Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit determination for this project is the Department of Environmental Protection, Northeast District, Waste and Air Resources Management Program, 8800 Baymeadows Way West, Suite 100, Jacksonville, Florida 32256. The Permitting Authority's telephone and FAX numbers are respectively 904-256-1700 and 904-256-1587.

Petitions: A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed with (received by) the Department's Agency Clerk in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Agency.Clerk@dep.state.fl.us and Telephone: 850/245-2241). Petitions must be filed within 14 days of receipt of this permit extension. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Permitting Authority's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of when and how each petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed decision; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and, (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this written notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

EXTENSION OF AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT EXPIRATION DATE

Effective Date: This permitting decision is final and effective on the date filed with the clerk of the Department unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above paragraphs or unless a request for extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within the time specified for filing a petition pursuant to Rule 62-110.106, F.A.C., and the petition conforms to the content requirements of Rules 28-106.201 and 28-106.301, F.A.C. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for extension of time, this action will not be effective until further order of the Department.

Judicial Review: Any party to this permitting decision (order) has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68, F.S., by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, Mail Station #35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The notice must be filed within 30 days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.


