This air permit extension modifies the expiration date of the existing permit No. 0110061-007-AC from April 11, 2010 to April 11, 2013 in accordance with Rule 62-4.080 (3), F.A.C., and the permit extension request letter received on February 14, 2012. The extended permit shall comply with the standards and conditions required by the existing construction permit No. 0110061-007-AC. This letter must be attached to existing permit No. 0110061-007-AC and becomes a part of the extended permit.


The status of construction activities permitted by permit No. 0110061-007-AC is:

- A dome was added to Tank 8708, installation of domes onto 8706 and 8707 are pending.
- Blending equipment was added to the rack to allow for ethanol/gasoline loading

This letter constitutes final agency action unless a person substantially affected by this action requests an administrative hearing pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition for administrative hearing must conform to the requirements of Chapters 62-103 and 28-5.201, F.A.C, and must be filed with the Clerk of the Department in the legal office (Broward County Attorney, 115 S. Andrews Avenue, Suite 423, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301-1872), within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this letter. Failure to file a petition within the fourteen (14) days constitutes a waiver of any right such person has to an administrative determination (hearing) pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes and Chapter 27. This permit extension is final unless a petition is filed in accordance with this paragraph or unless a request for extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within the time specified for filing a petition and conforms to Rule 62-103.070, FAC. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for an extension of time, this permit will not be effective until further Order of the PPRAQD.

When the Order (Permit) is final, any party to the Order has the right to seek judicial review of the Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the legal office, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department.
