Minor Air Construction and Operation Permits
Mulberry Facility

These permits modify Emission Unit No. 001 – Soil Thermal Treatment Facility by allowing the emissions unit to also process the following four (4) types of contaminated soil/materials:

- Liquid biofuel contaminated soil;
- Liquid biofuel tank bottom sludge from liquid biofuel storage tanks systems;
- Liquid biofuel contaminated sediments, sludge, and liquids which originate from oil/water separators at residential car washes, rollover car washes, and tunnel car washes; and
- Liquid biofuel contaminated sediments, sludge, and liquids which originate from oil/water separators/sumps, other than car washes.

Minor administrative changes are also addressed in these permits.

NOTICE AND PUBLICATION

The Permitting Authority distributed a draft minor air construction and operation permit package on July 26, 2012. The applicant published the Public Notice in The Ledger on August 6, 2012. The Permitting Authority received the proof of publication on August 7, 2012. No requests for administrative hearings or requests for extensions of time to file a petition for administrative hearing were received.

COMMENTS

Public

On August 17, 2012, the Permitting Authority received comments from Ms. Nada Harrison via e-mail.

Ms. Harrison expressed concerns about permits issued in the vicinity of her home, and opposition to pollution sources in her area due to health concerns. Ms. Harrison also made comments about other issues not relevant to the Department's proposed action.

FINAL DETERMINATION

Ms. Nada Harrison's e-mail in its entirety is in the Permitting Authority's file for Clark Environmental, Inc. and available upon request.

Response: Since the purpose of the public notice was to give the public an opportunity to comment in accordance with Rule 62-210.350, F.A.C., the Department limited its response to the scope of these permits. The Permitting Authority's air permitting engineers reviewed the application to ensure that the facility has provided reasonable assurance the facility will continue to meet existing air pollution control requirements. A technical evaluation of the application concluded that the emission limits proposed by the applicant will meet all the requirements of Chapters 62-204 through 297, Florida Administrative Code, relating to the Department's air pollution control regulations. It is the Department's opinion that no significant environmental impact is expected from the proposed activity.

Additionally, Clark Environmental, Inc. has been operating in compliance with their existing operating permit conditions and emission limits and has met all of the requirements of the Department's air pollution regulations.

CONCLUSION

No changes were made to the draft permits. The permitting authority hereby issues the FINAL Permits, with no changes.
