Dear Mr. McRae:

This is in response to your application received March 19, 1998 requesting relocation of your portable rock crusher from Santa Rosa County Industrial Park to 5437 Star Avenue in Panama City, and your April 14, 1998 request to increase your production rate. By this letter permit 7775029-003-AC is amended as follows:

1. Amend the location on the first page of the permit as follows:

From:

Located: At the Santa Rosa County Industrial Park, North of Highway 90, at the end of Progress Road.

To:

Located: Southwest of the intersection of Highway 231 and State Road 719 at 5437 Star Avenue.

2. Amend specific condition number 4 on page two of the permit as follows:

From:

The maximum allowable operating rate is 100 tons per hour. This is the operating rate at which compliance with the standards will be demonstrated.
[FAC Rule 62-4.070 and construction permit application].

To:

The maximum allowable operating rate is 145 tons per hour. This is the operating rate at which compliance with the standards will be demonstrated.
[Rule 62-4.070, F.A.C.]

All other specific conditions of this permit remain in effect. This letter shall be attached to and made part of permit 7775029-003-AC.
