Dear Mr. Sparks:

On February 14, 2014, you submitted an application requesting permission to install ductwork between the boilers and continuous kilns to facilitate recovery of thermal energy from the boiler combustion gases. The boilers will exhaust through multiclones to the steam-heated continuous lumber drying kilns to provide additional heat for drying wood. This facility is located in Liberty County approximately 6 miles south of State Road 12 in Bristol, Florida.

WRITTEN NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AIR PERMIT

stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this written notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available in this proceeding.
