Pinellas County Resource Recovery Facility  
Facility Improvement Projects, Permit Extension

On December 2, 2013, the Department received your request for an extension of the expiration date from December 31, 2013 to December 31, 2016 on Air Construction Permit No. 1030117-009-AC (PSD-FL-420) related to Facility Improvement Projects, Emissions Standards and Process Limits at the Pinellas County Resource Recovery Facility. [County Extension Request](#) The existing facility is located at 3001 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue North in St. Petersburg, Florida. The UTM coordinates are Zone 17, 335.273 km East, and 3084.304 km North.

According to the application, *“The County wishes to extend the expiration date of the permit until December 31, 2016 because the County wants to ensure that it has sufficient time for:*

- (1) “A second round of stack testing under the new, stricter permit limits and a determination as to whether any facility improvements are needed to consistently and reliably comply with the new BACT limits;*
- (2) “Implementation of any improvements to the facility’s air pollution control system that are identified as a result of the current studies being performed by the County and the facility operator; and*
- (3) “The completion of certain projects that the County anticipates will be identified during the procurement process and included as part of the new contract”.*

Based on the circumstances, information provided and the Department’s Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination dated January 6, 2014, the Department hereby extends the permit through December 31, 2016.

Section 2, Specific Condition 8 of Permit No. 1030117-009-AC (PSD-FL-420) is modified as follows:

**Title V Permit:** This permit authorizes specific modifications and/or new construction on the affected emissions units as well as initial operation to determine compliance with conditions of this permit. A Title V operation permit is required for regular operation of the permitted emissions unit. The permittee shall apply for a Title V operation permit **at least 90 days prior to expiration of this permit, but no later than December 3, 2015 180 days after completing the required work and commencing operation.** To apply for a Title V operation permit, the applicant shall submit the appropriate application form, compliance test results, and such additional information as the Department may by law require. The application shall be submitted to the appropriate Permitting Authority with copies to each Compliance Authority. [Rules 62-4.030, 62-4.050, 62-4.220, and Chapter 62-213, F.A.C.]

## EXTENSION OF AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT EXPIRATION DATE

Upon issuance of this final permit, Any party to this permitting decision (order) has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68, F.S., by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel, Mail Station #35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000, [Agency.Clerk@dep.state.fl.us](mailto:Agency.Clerk@dep.state.fl.us) , and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The notice must be filed within 30 days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.
