Pursuant to Section 403.815, Florida Statutes and Rule 62-110.106, Florida Administrative Code, you are required to publish at your own expense a Notice of Intent to Issue Permit.

Please have the **PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT** published one time only in the legal advertisement section of a major newspaper of general circulation in Duval County, in the area close to where the project is located (affected areas) as soon as possible and no later than thirty (30) days from receipt of this notice.

Proof of publication through the submittal of the newspaper affidavit shall be provided to the Environmental and Compliance Department, Environmental Quality Division, within seven (7) days of publication. The processing of the application will be delayed until fourteen (14) days after this office has received the proof of publication. Failure to publish this Notice of Intent to Issue Permit will be basis for denial of the permit.
