**PROPOSED PERMIT DETERMINATION**

**I. Public Notice.**

An “INTENT TO ISSUE TITLE V AIR OPERATION PERMIT REVISION” to the United States Marine Corps, Marine Corps Support Facility – Blount Island, located at 5880 Channel View Blvd., Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida 32226-3404 was clerked on January 24, 2013. The “PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE TITLE V AIR OPERATION PERMIT REVISION” was published in the Florida Times-Union on February 6, 2013. The DRAFT Permit was available for public inspection at the Neighborhoods Department, Environmental Quality Division in Jacksonville, Florida. Proof of publication of the “PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE A TITLE V AIR OPERATION PERMIT” was received on February 7, 2013.
