Enclosed is Permit Number 0571287-005-AO for the surface coating and cleaning of metal and plastic parts as part of an aircraft maintenance facility, issued pursuant to Section 403.087, Florida Statutes.

The EPC will issue the final permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Section 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Legal Department of the EPC at 3629 Queen Palm Dr, Tampa, Florida 33619, Phone 813-627-2600, Fax 813-627-2602. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within 14 (fourteen) days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S. must be filed within 14 (fourteen) days of receipt of this permit. Under Section 120.60(3), however, any person who asked the EPC for notice of agency action may file a petition within 14 (fourteen) days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication.

A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing)

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
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Any party to this order has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes, by filing a notice of appeal under rule 9.110 of the Florida rules of Appellate Procedure with the EPC's Legal Office at 3629 Queen Palm Dr, Tampa, Florida 33619 and with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel, Mail Station 35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate district court of appeal. The notice must be filed within thirty days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.

This permit is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code Rules 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-296, 62-297, and 62-4. The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans, and other documents, attached hereto or on file with the EPC and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

This permit authorizes the surface coating and cleaning of metal and plastic parts as part of an aircraft maintenance facility. The facility applies spray coatings to aircraft parts within a fully enclosed paint booth. The paint booth is manufactured by JBL, Inc., Model EA-24-SB, with Serial No. 13158. The airflow through the booth is cross-draft and the overspray is captured on fifteen fiberglass mat filters (20"x20"). The performance of the overspray filters is measured by a pressure differential gauge. The coatings are applied with air-assisted, HVLP spray guns.

The spray guns and airplane parts that require cleaning are either hand-wiped with solvents or are washed in tub-type parts cleaners serviced by Heritage-Crystal Clean™. The facility has three parts washers on site. Each drains into a 55-gallon drum that remains covered with a lid when not in use to prevent solvent evaporation.

Volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) emissions are controlled by the use of best management practices and limits on the material usages. The facility is subject to 40 CFR 63 Subpart HHHHHH—National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants: Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating Operations at Area Sources. This NESHAP has not been adopted by the State of Florida.


SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

- A) Alteration or replacement of any equipment or major component of such equipment;
- B) Installation or addition of any equipment which is a source of air pollution.

15. Prior to sixty days before the expiration of this operating permit, the permittee shall apply for a renewal of the permit using the current version of the permit renewal application form. A renewal application shall be timely and sufficient. If the application is submitted prior to sixty days before the expiration of the permit, it will be considered timely and sufficient. If the renewal application is submitted at a later date, it will not be considered timely and sufficient unless it is submitted and made complete prior to the expiration of the operating permit. When the application for renewal is timely and sufficient, the existing permit shall remain in effect until the renewal application has been finally acted upon by the EPC or, if there is court review of the final agency action, until a later date is required by Section 120.60, Florida Statutes.

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
