

## STATEMENT OF BASIS

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### Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal Permit No. 1030508-004-AV

#### **APPLICANT**

The applicant for this project is Premium Leisure LLC. The applicant's responsible official and mailing address are: Mr. Art Zelenak, CFO, Premium Leisure LLC, 6101 North 45 Street, St. Petersburg, Florida 33714.

#### **FACILITY DESCRIPTION**

The applicant operates the Premium Leisure LLC facility, which is located at Pinellas County at 6101 North 45 Street, St. Petersburg, Florida.

The existing facility is a reinforced plastic composite production facility and includes activities such as preparation of molds, application of resin and gelcoat to molds, and product assembly. VOC and HAP are emitted fugitively from the resin/gel coat application process which utilizes both mechanical (non-atomized) and manual application techniques. The facility is synthetically limited to a maximum of 245 ton per year of VOC emissions and 98 tons per year of HAP emissions. Compliance with these limits are demonstrated with recordkeeping based on material usage and emissions calculations.

Also included in this permit are miscellaneous insignificant emissions units and/or activities.

#### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The purpose of this permitting project is to renew the existing Title V permit for the above referenced facility.

#### **PRIMARY REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS**

Title III: The facility is identified as a major source of hazardous air pollutants (HAP).

Title V: The facility is a Title V major source of air pollution in accordance with Chapter 62-213, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

PSD: The facility is not a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD)-major source of air pollution in accordance with Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C.

NSPS: The facility does not operate emissions units subject to the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) of 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 60.

NESHAP: The facility does operate emissions units subject to the National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) of 40 CFR 63.

CAIR: The facility is not subject to the Clean Air Interstate Rule (CAIR) set forth in Rule 62-296.470, F.A.C.

CAM: Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM) does not apply to any of the emissions units at the facility.

#### **PROJECT REVIEW**

This renewal reformats the Title V permit from the old format to the new and revised format that became the new standard for Title V renewal projects in 2011.

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### CONCLUSION

This project renews Title V air operation permit No. 1030508-002-AV, which was issued on March 6, 2007 and administratively corrected as project no. 1030508-003-AV. This Title V air operation permit renewal is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-213, F.A.C.
