Ms. Vardeh,

As I explained in a voice mail I left for you a few minutes ago, according to your current air permit 1050351-005-AO, "all sandblasting equipment operations shall be conducted in the three-sided enclosed building with containment screening" (Specific Condition A.1.a.) and "as an indicator the three-sided enclosed building is adequate, there shall be no visible emissions (5% opacity) emitted from the building. If visible emissions are emitted from the building, it will not be a violation in and of itself, but an indicator that additional controls and/or measures may be required" (Specific Condition B.5.).

As Department staff witnessed on 10/06/10, your current sandblasting building is in a bad shape and does not provide necessary containment. As such, please be advised that conducting sandblasting in the current building would violate the above-listed conditions of your permit. In order to avoid possible enforcement action, please refrain from conducting any further sandblasting until it can be done in the new structure. Another option would be to temporarily fix the old structure to the point where sandblasting could be done to comply with conditions A.1.a. and B.5.
