<p>On January 7, 2009, Mr. Rodell Rice of FDEP visited the subject facility for the annual compliance inspection. Contact was made with Mr. Darryl Johnson, the plant manager. The plant was not in operation at the time of the inspection. Mr. Rice picked up a copy of the required records. Mr. Rice reviewed the past twelve months of fuel analysis reports on site. The following conditions apply to operating conditions at the time of inspection:</p> <p><u>Facility-wide Conditions</u> No objectionable odors were detected on or off facility grounds. No areas were observed where reasonable precautions were not taken to minimize pollutant emissions. No areas were observed where reasonable precautions were not taken to prevent the release of unconfined particulate. No visible emissions were observed coming from the baghouse stack. The plant was not in operation.</p> <p><u>Emissions Units and Conditions</u> The following information pertains to the 12-month operating period ending December 2008: The plant produced 177,940.04 tons of asphalt, 16.9% of the 1.050 million tons permit limit. The total fuel consumption was 468,560 gallons, 17.9% of the permitted 2.61 million gallons permit limit. The plant operated for 1,249 hours, 41.6% of the 3,000 hours permit limit. The latest fuel analysis of used oil contained 0.38% sulfur, the permitted limit is 1.0%. The fuel also met the metals and halogen limits.</p>
