INSPECTION COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS: Ms. Wanda Parker-Garvin and Mr. Brad Whidden of FDEP visited the subject site to conduct a complaint and compliance inspection. Ms. Parker-Garvin made contact with Mr. John Van Seeters, Mr. Ray Guinn and Mr. Fred Iannotti of Halifax Paving and informed them that the Department had received a complaint of uncontrolled burning at the site. Mr. Guinn stated the facility had received four (4) burn permits from the Department of Forestry dating from November 30 th through December 5 th to burn land clearing debris. Mr. Guinn provided the permit numbers and dates. Ms. Parker-Garvin asked Mr. Guinn how the debris was burned and if the facility had an Air Curtain Incinerator (ACI). Mr. Guinn stated the debris had been burned 3 of the 4 days in an ACI the facility had for the past 10 years. He further stated the ACI had not been used in the last 8 years and it had broken during the last burn on December 4 th . Ms. Parker-Garvin informed Mr. Guinn, Mr. Seeters and Mr. Iannotti that pursuant to Rule 62-210.300(1)(a) F.A.C. the ACI required a permit and should have been in their current permit. She further informed them of the current regulations for permanent and temporary ACI units and gave them a copy of the rule reference. Mr. Seeters stated they were not aware the ACI needed to be included in the current permit and they would dismantle the unit and send photos. Mr. Seeters emailed photos of the dismantled unit to Ms. Parker-Garvin on December 10, 2012. (See photo log attached.) Mr. Seeters and Mr. Guinn accompanied Ms. Parker-Garvin and Mr. Whidden on a walk-through inspection of the asphalt plant and the crusher. The crusher which operates on electric power from FPL was being repaired and not operating at the time of inspection. The asphalt plant began operating on only natural gas on April 4, 2012. The baghouse had only 3 bags changed out in the past 3 years. The baghouse uses a rotary system which causes fewer maintenance of the unit. The plant has not had any major maintenance in the past year. The only diesel fuel currently being used at the facility is for on-road vehicles.

The facility utilized 104,028 gallons of fuel, 7.43% of the permitted 1,400,000 gallons per 12 month period. <p><u>Facility-wide and Emission Units Conditions</u></p> <p>No objectionable odors were detected.</p> <p>No areas were observed where reasonable precautions were not used to prevent unconfined particulate emissions.</p> <p>Based on the inspection, documentation provided and the presence of the ACI unit, Ms. Parker-Garvin found the facility to be out-of-compliance.
