<p>Wanda Parker-Garvin with FDEP visited the subject facility to perform a compliance inspection. She made contact with Mr. Rick Maugeri and Mr. Tim Stenroos of Marble Crafters. Mr. Stenroos and Mr. Maugeri accompanied Ms. Parker-Garvin on a walk-through of the facility. Mr. Stenroos stated that the cast polymer portion of their business was extremely slow and they would be shutting down that side of the business. The facility currently manufactures an occasional tub or vanity and windowsills for residential homes. Ms. Parker-Garvin observed windowsills, one vanity and several tub molds. There was a small grinding booth with a quadruple filter system. The facility was not operating at the time of inspection.</p> <p>Ms. Parker-Garvin asked to review the facility records. Mr. Stenroos stated that Ms. Mellisa Tardella handled the records, however she is not currently in the office. Ms. Parker-Garvin gave her business card to Mr. Maugeri and Mr. Stenroos and asked them to have Ms. Tardella to email the required records to her. Ms. Parker-Garvin received the requested records on Wednesday, December 12, 2012.</p> <p><u>Facility-wide Conditions</u> No objectionable odors were detected on or off facility property. No areas were observed where reasonable precautions were not used to prevent unconfined particulate emissions.</p> <p><u>Emissions Units and Conditions (December 2011 – November 2012)</u> The facility emitted 1.51 tons VOCs, 6.04% of the permit limit of 25.0 tons VOCs per 12-month period. The facility emitted 1.42 tons HAPs, 7.10% of the permit limit of 20.0 tons HAPs per 12-month period. The facility emitted 1.41 tons of HAPs, 15.67% of the permit limit is 9.0 tons of an individual HAPs per 12-month period.</p> <p>Based on the inspection and documentation provided, the facility was found to be in-compliance.</p>
