The facility was in operation at the time of the inspection. The majority of the concrete production portion of the property is paved and the entrance is swept regularly to control unconfined particulate matter.		
This concrete batch plant includes two silos that are each equip- controlled by a manual spray bar, which appeared to be in good	ipped with dust collectors. Emissions from the truck loading spout are od condition.	

Visible emissions tests are to be conducted on an annual basis. The last visible emission testing was conducted February 18 and 25,

2008. During the test, there were no visible emissions noted.
