The purpose of this notice is to advise you of possible violations of law for which you may be responsible, and to seek your cooperation in resolving the matter. Sarasota County Natural Resources (SCNR) personnel conducted a field inspection on the date listed above at the location described above. SCNR personnel observed the following, which indicates that a violation of Sarasota County Code and/or Florida Statutes and Rules may exist at the above described facility: (For Example: Where was the activity observed? How was it discovered? Who provided information to the inspector?)

Observations: No dust control observed as required in air operating permit. Excessive dust at the north side of property from heavy equipment operations.

<b>UNCONFINED PARTICULATE MATTER.</b> Sarasota County Code, Chapter 54, Article V, Section 54-115, adopts by reference Rule 62-296.320(4)(c) 1, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), provides that no person shall cause, let, permit, suffer or allow the emission of unconfined particulate matter from any activity, without taking reasonable precautions to prevent such emissions.	<b>X</b>
<b>OPERATING WITHOUT A PERMIT.</b> Sarasota County Code, Chapter 54, Article V, Section 54-115, adopts by reference Rule 62-210.300, F.A.C., provides that, unless exempted from permitting or unless specifically authorized, the owner or operator of any facility or emissions unit which emits or can reasonably be expected to emit any air pollutant shall obtain an appropriate permit from SCNR.	
<b>OBJECTIONABLE ODOR.</b> Sarasota County Code, Chapter 54, Article V, Section 54-115, adopts by reference Rule 62-296.320(2), F.A.C., provides that no person shall cause, suffer, allow or permit the discharge of air pollutants which cause or contribute to an objectionable odor.	
<b>EXCESSIVE VISIBLE EMISSIONS.</b> Sarasota County Code, Chapter 54, Article V, Section 54-115, adopts by reference Rule 62-296.320(4)(b) 1., F.A.C., provides that no person shall cause, let, permit, suffer or allow to be discharged into the atmosphere the emissions of air pollutants from any activity, the density of which is equal to or greater than 20 percent opacity.	<b>X</b>
<b>OPEN BURNING.</b> With few exceptions, Rule 62-296.320(3), F.A.C., prohibits open burning in connection with industrial, commercial, or municipal operations. Sarasota County Code, Chapter 54, Article V, Section 54-116 provides that no person shall ignite, cause to be ignited, permit to be ignited, or maintain any open fires unless and until the Sarasota County local air program has issued a permit for such ignition.	<b>X</b>
<b>STAGE 1 VAPOR CONTROLS.</b> Sarasota County Code, Chapter 54, Article V, Section 54-147 (c). <u>Mobile-source air pollution.</u> Bulk gasoline deliveries to dispensing stations, requires Stage 1 vapor controls at all gasoline dispensing facilities in Sarasota County with a monthly gasoline throughput of 20,000 gallons or more.

The activities observed during SCNR's field inspection and any other activities at your facility that may be contributing to violations of the above-described statutes or rules should be ceased. The operation of a facility in violation of Sarasota County Code, Florida Statutes or Rules may result in liability for damages and restoration, and the administrative imposition of penalties up to \$10,000.00 pursuant to Section 403.121, Florida Statutes (F.S.), or the judicial imposition of civil penalties up to \$10,000.00 per violation per day pursuant to Sections 403.141 and 403.161, F.S.

Please be advised that this Field Warning Notice is part of an agency investigation, preliminary to agency action in accordance with Section 120.57(5), F.S.
