**COMMENTS:** In a compliance inspectioin conducted on 06/25/2008, AQD satff observed operations at Sendure Products, Inc. The facility has one spray booth for painting heat exchangers. Mr. Tom Ghougasian (shop manager) accompanied staff on the inspection. The housekeeping was good. The facility also uses instapak foam which combines two different chemicals through an air hose (one component contains MDI). Mr. Ghougasian submitted the MSDS sheets to AQD staff and permitting staff are reviewing them. However, the two products combined do not volatilize and are not being sprayed (instapak is liquid foam that turns into a type of styrofoam for packing-this is all the facility is using it for).
