COMMENTS: On August 29, 2013 I visited this facility to conduct the annual compliance inspection. On site I met Many Lacsina, the Lead Pump Station Operator of the facility. This Pump Station consistes of three (3) flood control pumps powered by three (3) 325 HP Caterpillar C-11 ACERT (Tier III) diesel engines and two (2) 150 KW diesel emergency generators. A test ran is performed for thirty (30) minutes a week for the generators.
