Owner/operator failed to provide halogen leak detector (PERC leak detector) during the inspection.

#### Corrective Action Required:

Owner/operator must have the halogen leak detector on-site at all times.

Rule Cite\*: 62-213.300(3)(k) Code: AQ2.

#### Description of Violation:

Owner/operator failed to complete the FDEP calendar for PERC dry-cleaners and add his PERC purchases to the rolling average.

#### **Corrective Action Required:**

Owner/operator must include his PERC purchases in his PERC consumption rolling averages.
