

Operation Description at Time of Inspection:

PERC Dry-Cleaner

Inspector Comments: (Refer to the Violations Found on This Inspection page for violations cited, if any)

In a compliance inspection conducted on 06/22/2011, AQR staff (E.Susky) observed operations at Crown 1 Hour Cleaners. The facility has one PERC dry-cleaning machine. Mr. Ara Bastajian (owner) accompanied staff on the inspection. Housekeeping at the facility is very good. Drums of hazardous materials are in proper containment and labeled. The spotting board area has epoxy paint beneath it. Mr. Bastajian is utilizing the FDEP dry-cleaning calendar, and is recording the leak checks, temperature checks and rolling averages. However, he needed to add his purchases to the averages. Mr. Bastajian also was not able to show his PERC leak monitor while staff was present for the inspection.

Violations Found During this Inspection

Rule Cite*: 27-173 **Code:** H40.F

Description of Violation:

Owner/operator failed to provide halogen leak detector (PERC leak detector) during the inspection.

Corrective Action Required:

Owner/operator must have the halogen leak detector on-site at all times.

Rule Cite*: 62-213.300(3)(k) **Code:** AQ2.

Description of Violation:

Owner/operator failed to complete the FDEP calendar for PERC dry-cleaners and add his PERC purchases to the rolling average.

Corrective Action Required:

Owner/operator must include his PERC purchases in his PERC consumption rolling averages.
