COMMENTS: In a compliance inspection conducted on 4/10/2013, AQD staff (E. Susky) observed operations at Broward Shipyard. Mr. Albert Hernandez submitted VOC records to the department. The facility is operating under their permit threshold. Mr. Hernandez accompanied staff on the inspection. The facility has a large yard, boat hanger, haz-mat storage and offices. Housekeeping was good and the facility encapsulates its boats on the water and off when they conduct painting work. The haz-mat storage area was properly maintained and Mr. Hernandez stated that their diesel tanks were double-walled.
