Mr. Dan Kingston accompanied staff on the inspection. He submitted VOC records to the department. Approximately highest daily average was 16 VOC per day. Houskeeping was excellent and record-keeping was very good. The faciltiy has a boat pull-out recyclable area, paint shed with bermed haz-mat area and small parts spray booth in the hangar. The faciltiy adheres to the Mariana BMP.
