This facility operates with six Diesel-Fueled engines & eight electric engines. The diesel fuel usage for the year 2009 was 131,119 gallons. Mr.Richard M. O'Rourke, Supervisor, Miami-Dade Water & Sewer Department sent the annual reading to me via email on January 04, 2010.
