COMMENTS: Gate was closed and no sign of operating could be seen from street view. General Permit Entitlement expired in May 2012. Phone call in the field to Owner Authorized Representative number above yeilded only busy signal. Phone call from office at 2:37pm on this day was busy signal also. Multiple attempts to contact facility all resulted in a busy signal. According to correspondence with Mr. Louis Valvo in July 2009 the facility was not operating due to the decline in housing market and lack of business. A review of SunBiz.org revealed that All About Marble applied for dissolution in 2003. I found no website and no evidence of operations for this facility. Facility should be inactivated.
