On June 23, 2008 the Department conducted a routine inspection of the above facility.

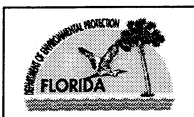
During the inspection it was found that the facilities Air General Permit Registration expired on February 6, 2008.

The general permit is not transferable and does not follow a change in ownership of the facility. Prior to any sale, other change of ownership, or permanent shutdown of the facility, the responsible official shall notify the Department.



A field warning notice was left so facility owner had 15 days to contact the Department.

All record keeping paperwork was received.

Permit not applied for according ARMS Data Base 07/14/2008

This inspection will be referred to Enforcement.

Inspected calendars and Perchloroethylene purchasing records from 2006, 2007, 2008. Mr. William Chamberlin was not keeping up the rolling monthly average because he wasn't sure how to calculate it. To bring Mr. William Chamberlin to date we spent time going over how to calculate rolling average in the calendar.

Gave Mr. William Chamberlin copy of the rule/registration. Asked him to send it to Tallahassee (provided contact phone #), a SBEAP Fact Sheet, SOCR, handout with the SBEAP ombudsman's contact information and a statement on it telling him new rules will be coming out in the next 6-8 months. To stay current contact the ombudsman periodically. Provided separator water guidelines from SBEAP web site. Original and some copied records were sent in for verification. I had them mailed back to Tender Touch Cleaners return receipt. Also called Mr. William Chamberlin on 07/14/2008 to let him know to send in the SOCR I left during the inspection. He said he doesn't remember the SOCR but will look in the papers I left w/ him and if he can't find it I nsaid call me and I will email him one.
