COMMENTS: Facility has exceeded their Air General Permit limit of 284, 000 pounds of amount of styrene containing resin and gelcoat used in a consecutive 12 month period. The facility's total for the last 12 consecutive months is 361,810 pounds of styrene containing resin and gelcoat used. Facility will now require a FESOP or higher level permit from the Department to continue to operate.
