I advised him he may need to take additional precautions to prevent odors off the property to avoid odor complaint issues.		
I advised him that his south door being open during laminations process could cause odors to be carried off property. I informed him		
Of could result in objectionable odors, and verification could result in warning letters, penalties etc.


