**COMMENTS:** The combined quantity of styrene containing resin and gelcoat used for the last twelve consecutive months (Nov. 2012 thru Oct. 2013 was 30,740 lbs. A small open bucket containing a few onces of acetone was noted uncovered in the mixing and waxing area of the facility and was corrected ( contained) during the inspection. The sanding dust noted on the floor is cleaned up daily according to the facility owner so it is not released into the environment.
