COMMENTS: In a compliance inspection conducted on 4/11/2013 AQD staff (E. Susky) observed operations at Harbour Towne Marina. The facility is a full service marina that has a work pad where boat maintenance and painting is conducted. Mr. Barry Armband (manager) accompanied staff on the inspection. He submitted VOC records to the department and the facility is at 14.26 VOC/lbs/day. This is well under the threshold for their permit. The facility is in the process of repaving their work pad. The hazardous material storage was well maintained and vessels were observed to have proper tarping beneath them and tarping around them. The facility makes an effort to adhere to the marina BMP (Best Management Practices). They still utilize the geotextile that they were nominated for an Emerald Award for.
