The facility is a full service marina that conducts boat painting and maintenance on a work pad/area that is fenced in. They have two travel lifts and a recycleable system The facility still utilizes the geotextile underneath it's vessels when they are conducting work. The facility is still in the process of repaving the work yard. Mr. Armband was not available to accompany staff on the inspection, however another yard manager was available. Mr. Armband will submit the VOC records to the department. A copy of the updated Marina BMP video information was distributed.
