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**COMMENTS:** In a compliance inspection conducted on 4/4/2011, AQD staff (E.Susky) observed operations at Marine Mile Yachting Center. The facility is a boat yard that conducts bottom work on smaller vessels. Mr. David Hole (Yard Manager) accompanied staff on the inspection. Housekeeping was much better this year and Mr. Hole submitted VOC records. Daily VOC usages vary from 12.74 to 14.46 daily, well below their permit threshold.
