**COMMENTS:** In a compliance inspection conducted on 02/24/2009, AQD staff observed operations at Cable Marine East. The facility mainly consists of a pull-out area (for maintenance and bottom work), wood shop, paint shop, offices and boat storage. The haz-mat storage area is located on the East side of the building near the boat pull-out. Houskeeping was just o.k and the use oil drum 55 gallon drum was observed without its lid on. Mr. Keith Willis was on-site during the inspection and he was infromed of this observation. He stated that they he would address the average houskeeping right away and mentioned that work on two larger yachts had just been conducted prior to t the inspection.

The VOC logs will be submitted by the main office (also utilizing Envirocare Consultants). AQD staff questioned Mr. Willis whether they conducted a lot of resin work this year and he stated that very little resin was utilized.
