COMMENTS: In a compliance inspection conducted on 02/25/2010, AQD staff observed operations at Cable Marine West. Mr. Alex Reyes accompanied staff on the inspection. The facility is a marina with on-water slips for painting, working yard (for repairs), pull out area (with recycable system), boat storage and offices. Housekeeping was good and has improved steadily over the past years. One 55 gallon drum of resin was observed in the hazardous materials storage area. VOC records were sent by the consultant. Facility is under the 44lbs/day/VOC threshold.
