This facility has a work yard, on water painting bays, offices and dockage. The yard manger (Alex) accompanied staff on the inspection. The yard houskeeping was okay and could use a bit of improvement. Alex did state that the facility had an influx of vessels during August which is usually the slower season. One large vessel observed in a dry work bay was having resin work, engine work and eventually painting. Resin usages will be monitored. VOC usages are emailed to the department from the main office.
