Tiffany Rush, owner, stated she could not stop doing her work to compile the records for the inspectors, she was unaware that records need to be kept as a monthly log. The inspectors told tiffany that the permit requires the facility to maintain monthly logs for rein and gelcoat usage. She requested the inspectors to come back at 8:00 am tomorrow morning. On 5/7/2010 facility was in compliance. Records show 54946 pounds of resin and gelcoat were purchased from July 2009 to April 2010.
