**COMMENTS:** In a compliance inspection conducted on 01/31/2012, AQD staff (E.Susky) observed operations at Billfish Marina. The facility is a marina that conducts bottom painting on boats. Mr. Rick Van Lenten (manager) accompanied staff on the inspection. Houskeeping is good and Mr. Van Lenten and assistant (Lorraine Welter) keep excellent records. VOC logs were submitted during the inspection. The facility is below their permit threshold. Mr. Van Lenten stated that they had removed the sink that had been present in one of the work bays (was not properly discharged/referrd to Water) and AQD staff observed that it had been removed.
