**COMMENTS:** On February 10, 2012, an unannounced inspection was conducted at the Marble Works of Pensacola facility located at 3434 West Old Fairfield Drive in Pensacola, Escambia County. The facility is a cast polymer operation that fabricates bathroom fixtures such as sinks, shower stalls and bathtubs. The facility was in operation at the time of the inspection. No objectionable odors were noticed from the outside of the building. During the past 12 months, the facility has used a total of 15,810 lbs of styrene-containing materials, which is well below the permit limit of 284, 000 pounds.
