The applicators are cleaned bi-weekly. Filters are changed every week. All gel coat material was sealed. The RO will fax AQD the 12-mo consecutive total records on 10/7/09. Records were not received. Mr. Wilson asked for an extension which was granted. He stated he would have the records submitted by noon on 10/19/09. AQD did not receive it. This is second violation in 2 years regarding recordkeeping submittal. A warning letter with CO will be sent to the facility.[jm]
