The facility has four prep stations, three automotive spray booths and a haz-mat area. Mr. Bill Condron accompanied staff on the inspection. The houskeeping was excellent and Mr. Condron also showed staff the facilies efforts to recycle plastics and metals. Mr. Condron emailed the department his VOC records and his VOC/lbs/day is approximately 25.45 (averaging 12 months). The facility is below their thereshold for a the surfacce coating general permit.
