COMMENTS: In a compliance inspection conducted on 2/28/2013, AQD staff (E. Susky) observed operations at New River Marina. The facility is a boat yard that does bottom work and minor maintenance on boats. Mr. John Connor accompanied staff on the inspection. The facility has hazardous waste storage (oil and bottom paint) in a shed at the back of the yard. The drums were observed to be labeled and there was a containment pan beneath the drums. Houskeeping was okay. The facility does put tarps beneath the vessels they are working on, but some of the tarps were observed to need replacement. AQD staff communicated this to Mr. Connor. Mr. Connor showed AQD staff the facility's hand written VOC records. He will be submitting the finalized records to the department.
