COMMENTS: In a compliance inspection conducted on 2/29/2012, AQD staff (E.Susky) observed operations at Foam Factory. The facility makes structures out of foam that are utilized for interior decoration. The facility has one spray booth and one stucco booth and two detailing stucco areas. The containers of resin are stored in secondary containment. Mr. Stan Regent (owner) accompanied AQD staff (E.Susky) on the inspection. He stated the filters in the booths are changed daily. Houskeeping was good. The facility keeps excellent records of VOC usage and resins. At this time time they did not exceed their permit threshold.
