**COMMENTS:** A facility walk-through was conducted to observe operating conditions for the spray paint booths. The booths appeared to be operating properly. No objectionable odors were detected. Records were provided for the period February 2007 through May 2008. For the past twelve months, the highest observed lbs/day for VOCs was from July 2007 with 22.48 pounds. This is below the permit limit of 44 lbs/day. No objectionable odors were detected. No unconfined or uncontrolled emissions were observed.
