			Total fuel consumption by all heating units and general purpose internal combustion engines within the facility is limited to 250,000 gallons per year of diesel fuel, 22,000 gallons per year of gasoline, 35 million standard cubic feet per year of natural gas or propane, or an equivalent prorated amount if multiple fuels are used. [62-210.300(3)(c)3.d., F.A.C.]  Comments: Reviewed records for the months of 1-1-09 to 7-13-10. The highest reported annual usage was gallons of diesel; gallons of gasoline; mmcf of natural gas. Supporting
			documentation was available ( Yes or No).  Note: The highest reported annual usage was not recorded. Mr. Nick Turker stated on Sunday 11 <sup>th</sup> of July, 2010 they test ran the 436KW generator for 2 hours. He stated they noted that the City of Clearwater gas meter did not register consumption. According to Mr. Turker the emission unit was shutdown and have not run it since. He stated he notified the City of Clearwater's Natural Gas Division to have gas meter replace and have received notification back from the City that it is being addressed and the meter will be replace. Mr. Turker stated they will not run the generators until this issue is corrected. He stated they expected the City of Clearwater to be by this coming Friday, the 16 July 2010.
			The owner or operator of the facility maintains records to document the fuel consumption, by type, for each emissions unit. The owner or operator shall retain these records, available for Department inspection, for a period of at least five years. [62-210.300(3)(c)3.e., F.A.C.]  *Comments: The records were available back to 1/2006. 12 month consecutive totals \subseteq were not available. A partial copy of the records are attached as an example of the record format.
			The owner or operator voluntarily encourages pollution prevention through such measures as employing energy conservation measures to reduce the demand for heat from any heating units, maintaining heating units to ensure efficient heat recovery, considering the use of economizers to recycle waste heat back into the combustion air stream, developing operating procedures to reduce the load on any internal combustion engines, and considering the use of alternative fuels. [62-210.300(4)(b)2.b., F.A.C.]  Comments: The facility has a maintenance contract for the unit to keep it at maximum efficiency. The installed additional heat recovery heat exchanger are in operation which recover the waste heat from the generator and utilize it to heat the hot water for the Church of Scientology Fort Harrison Ave Hotel, reducing the demand for the natural gas boilers.
