I calculated from the combined totals, the amounts of styrene products which are from the, Mr. Witkamps productions since he became the new owner of the business.

The Highest total for the consecutive 12 month period under the new owner was 69,826 lbs, which is below the emission limitation of 76,000 lbs. The totals for the new owner, from this point on will be what are considered for this source in regards to the general permit emission limitation. The consecutive totals have been dropping off, and the current total for October was 57,896lbs for the consecutive cumulative total. This is in compliance of the general permit conditions.
