COMMENTS: Elite Marble was not in operation at the time of the inspection. All equipment and products have been removed from the building. The exhaust stack still remains on the north outside of the building, but it is not connected to any device on the inside. A small scale production carpentry shop now exists which is owned and operated by Full Sail media school. Various furniture, accessories, and theatrical sets are manufactured for the school on a limited basis. The operator stated that he was working there when Elite Marble ceased operation and he asserts that they disposed of all equipment and staff and had not merely moved their facility to another location. No debris or fugitive emissions were noted.
