Filters are changed in a regular basis, last time was 02/16/2006, as well as when the spray booth manometer reads 0.30, as manufacturer requirements. Recordkeeping available and maintained. The license will expire in Oct. 2007. No changes observed to the spray booth. Paint used is water based, therefore very low VOC content. Mr. Casagrande mentioned that he will implement a log to keep track when the filters are changed. No air violations observed.
