**COMMENTS:** This facility was not built. I spoke on the telephone with Mr. Chapman and was told that the plant was not built and because of the present housing/credit situation there are no immediate plans for its construction. However the plans for the construction of the other phases of the resort are still active and it is expected that once the housing market rebounds, this plant will be built. I informed Mr. Chapman that the Department must be notified if the plant is relocated or put into use at this location, and that the plant will need to have visible emissions testing performed prior to being placed into operation. As part of the inspection I did go to the physical location for the plant and confirmed that it does not exist.
