COMMENTS: Norma Ali met with Barbra Rama on January 17, 2013. The inspector conducted a walkthrough inspection and records audit. This facility does construction for entertainment, TV commercials and TV sets. The inspector observed a wood shop, metal shop, one enclosed spray booth, one partially-enclosed spray booth and fiber glass area. According to Mr. Rama, the operations are slow, but better than previous years, employees present, but no activity at the time of inspection. Ms. Rama provided the records from December 2011 to November 2012, which showed the highest consecutive 12-month rolling total for resin gelcoat was from December 2011 with 7.27 tons, this is below the permit limit of 38.0 tons. The facility was in good condition. No PM, leaks, spill were observed, no objectionable odors noted.
