COMMENTS: The EPD inspectors, Norma Ali and Omar Horta met with Barbra Rama on January 15, 2013. The inspectors conducted a walktrhough of the facility and obtained the records specify in the General Permit. This facility does contruction for entertainment, TV commercials and TV sets. The inspectors observed a wood shop, which was not operating at the time of inspection. Also observed a metal shop, one enclosed spray booth, one partially-enclosed spray booth and fiber glass area. According to Ms. Rama, business is picking up. Ms Rama provided the records from December 2012 to November 2013, which showed the highest consecutive 12-month rolling total for resin gelcoat was during December 2012 with 7.27 tons, this is below the permit limit of 38.0 tons. The facility was in good condition. No PM, leaks, spill were observed, no objectionable odors noted.
