Rule 62-296.401(5), F.A.C.

(5) Human Crematories.

(h) Frequency of Testing.

1. The owner or operator of any human crematory unit using an air general permit shall have a performance test conducted for visible emissions no later than thirty (30) days after the unit commences operation, and annually thereafter.

2. The owner or operator of any human crematory unit operating under the authority of an air construction permit or air operation permit shall have a performance test conducted for visible emissions prior to submitting the application for an initial air operation permit, and annually thereafter.

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SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

Testing and Compliance Documentation Requirements

15. Visible Emissions (VE) Testing

- A. In order to document compliance with the visible emissions (VE) limitation of Specific Condition No. 6, the crematory incinerator exhaust stack shall be **tested for visible emissions (VE) based upon which type of operation permit will be applied for** (see *Specific Condition No. 26*) **as follows:**
1. If an air **general permit** will be applied for then a VE test **shall be conducted during the 60-day period prior to the submittal of the air general permit notification form.** (See Part II, item (4)(k)1 of the *Human Crematory Air General Permit Notification Form*) and no later than (sixty) 60 days after initial start of commercial operation of the unit.
